Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Provides funds for local teacher certification support systems. These funds must be distributed to local entities based on an amount of \$100 per teacher.

This bill provides annual General Fund appropriations of \$1,440,000 in fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03 for the Department of Education to provide block grants to local teacher certification support systems based on an amount of \$100 per teacher.
