Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §306-A, sub-§5-A, as enacted by PL 1997, c. 689, Pt. B, §18 and affected by Pt. C, §2, is amended to read:

5-A. Public hearing. Within 30 days of the filing of an application, the department shall advertise and conduct in a location convenient to the proposal location a public informational--meeting hearing at which the applicant shall
present information about the proposal. Members of the public must be allowed to present testimony.

SUMMARY

16 Current law requires the Department of Human Services to advertise and hold a public informational meeting at which an applicant for a certificate of need for the construction or modification of health care facilities is required to present 20 information about the proposal.

22 This bill instead requires the department to advertise and hold a public hearing at which the applicant presents information 24 about the proposal and the public is allowed to present testimony.
