28	This bill may increase prosecutions for Class C crimes.
30	Sentences of more than 9 months imposed for Class C crimes must be served in state correctional institutions. The cost to the
32	State per sentence is \$71,306 based upon an average length of stay of 2 years and 5 months.

	The Judicial Department may require additional General Fund appropriations to cover indigent defense costs related to these
36	new cases. The amounts can not be estimated at this time. The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the
38	minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial
