
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 623, L.D. 823, Bill, "An Act to Discourage Environmental Terrorism"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1-A by inserting at the end a new blocked paragraph to read:

'This subsection does not apply to a person who is protesting the practices of a business during a labor dispute, strike or lockout at that business.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that the provisions of the bill do not apply to a person who is protesting the practices of a business during a labor dispute, strike or lockout at that business.
