HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 623, L.D. 823, Bill, "An Act to Discourage Environmental Terrorism"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1-A in the 3rd line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or destructive" and inserting in its place the following: 'or a crime of violence destructive'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the crime of environmental terrorizing only applies to the destruction of property or business practices if the act is a violent crime.
