	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6957, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1995, c. 169,
4	$\S2$, is further amended to read:
б	 Prohibition. A person may not operate a vessel using drags, otter trawls, pair trawls, beam trawls, scottish seines or
8	midwater trawls to fish for or take finfish, shellfish, sea urchins or any other marine organisms within 300 feet of any
10	suspended culture floating cages, tray racks or other floating equipment authorized in a <u>an aquaculture</u> lease issued-by-th e
12	eommissioner-undersection-6072, if the equipment is marked in accordance with subsection 1-A.

16	SUMMARY
18	This bill extends the prohibition against fishing near floating aquaculture equipment to all such equipment authorized
20	in any aquaculture lease.
