2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1825-B, sub-§11 is enacted to read:**

6 11. Toll calling and phone card services bid.  
8 Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, the Director  
10 of the Bureau of General Services shall purchase annually toll  
12 calling and phone card services for all departments and agencies  
14 of the State through competitive bidding.

12 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill requires the Director of the Bureau of General  
16 Services within the Department of Administrative and Financial  
18 Services to purchase toll calling and phone card services for all  
state departments and agencies on an annual basis through  
competitive bidding.
