2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated
4 from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

14 All Other \$85,000

16 Provides for the one-time appropriation of
18 funds for the Commissioner of Defense,
18 Veterans and Emergency Management to arrange
20 with the United States Department of the
20 Interior, National Park Service through the
22 Superintendent of Gettysburg National
22 Military Park for the maintenance of Maine's
24 monuments at Gettysburg National Military
24 Park. Funds appropriated for this purpose
26 may not lapse until 12 months after the
26 effective date of this Act.

28 **SUMMARY**

30 This bill funds the Maine Civil War Monuments Maintenance
32 Program within the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency
32 Management with a one-time appropriation of \$85,000 in fiscal
34 year 2001-02 for the Commissioner of Defense, Veterans and
34 Emergency Management to arrange with the United States Department
36 of the Interior, National Park Service through the Superintendent
36 of Gettysburg National Military Park for the maintenance of
38 Maine's monuments at Gettysburg National Military Park.
