COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 643, L.D. 843

2 (1) During recess; 4 (2) When children are going to or leaving school during school opening or closing hours. For purposes of this paragraph, school opening and closing hours are 6 1/2 hour before and 1/2 hour after the beginning of the school day and 1/2 hour before and 1/2 hour after the 8 end\_of the school\_day; 10 (3) When school speed limit signs are flashing during 12 school opening or closing hours; or 14 (4) At other times designated by a municipal traffic ordinance that regulates town ways that are classified as local by the Department of Transportation in 16 accordance with the federal functional classification 18 system.' 20 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following: 22 24 **'FISCAL NOTE** 26 The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial 28 The collection of additional fines may increase Department. General Fund revenue by minor amounts.' 30 32 **SUMMARY** 34 This amendment replaces the bill and requires a maximum rate of 15 miles per hour in a school zone during recess, when 36 children are going to or leaving school during school opening or closing hours, when school speed limit signs are flashing during 38 school opening or closing hours or at other times designated by a municipal traffic ordinance that regulates town ways that are 40 classified as local by the Department of Transportation in 42 accordance with the federal functional classification system. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
