HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 653, L.D. 853, Bill, "An Act to Ensure Access to Assisted Living Services Programs"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd indented paragraph after the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1 in the first line (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "20" and inserting in its place the following: '21'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1 in paragraph C in the first line (page 1, line 46 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Six" and inserting in its place the following: 'Seven'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1 in paragraph C in the last 2 lines (page 2, lines 2 and 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "a representative of Maine hospitals that provide assisted living services" and inserting in its place the following: '2 representatives of assisted living services providers'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 4 in paragraph A in the last line (page 2, line 40 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "data." the following: 'The commission shall also study and propose changes to existing law to facilitate and properly compensate providers for the delivery of services that allow consumers to choose to remain and reside in an assisted living facility while aging without compromising


