Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 4 in 2 paragraph A in the last line (page 2, line 40 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "data." the following: 'The 4 commission shall also study and propose changes to existing law to facilitate and properly compensate providers for the delivery 6 of services that allow consumers to choose to remain and reside in an assisted living facility while aging without compromising 8 the quality of care, the safety of consumers or the financial, administrative or residential care capabilities of the providers 10 of assisted living services.'

Further amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all of subsection 6 and inserting in its place the following:

Members of the commission who are 16 '6. Reimbursement. Legislators are entitled to receive the legislative per diem, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 2 and 18 reimbursement for necessary expenses incurred for the attendance 20 at authorized meetings of the commission. Other members of the commission who are not otherwise compensated by their employers 22 or other entities that they represent are entitled to receive reimbursement of necessary expenses incurred for their attendance at authorized meetings.' 24

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 7 in the first line (page 3, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Report." and inserting in its place the following: 'Meetings; report. The commission shall hold 4 meetings.'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 7 in the 32 3rd line (page 3, line 18 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "December 1" and inserting in its place the 34 following: 'December 5'

36 Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 7 in the last line (page 3, line 20 in L.D.) by inserting after the 38 following: "Legislature." the following: 'If the commission requires a limited extension of time to conclude its work, it may 40 apply to the Legislative Council, which may grant the extension.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the summary the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the 6 preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'

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Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read 10 consecutively.

#### FISCAL NOTE

14 The amendment eliminates the General Fund cost of the bill, originally estimated to be \$6,160 in fiscal year 2001-02, by removing the appropriation section included in the bill. Funding 16 for legislative studies has been included in the Governor's 18 supplemental "Part 2" budget as amended by Committee Amendment "A."

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The additional costs associated with providing staffing 22 assistance to the Commission to Study Assisted Living during the interim between legislative sessions can be absorbed by the 24 Legislature utilizing existing budgeted resources. Ιf an extension of the reporting deadline is granted and the commission requires staffing assistance during the legislative session, the 26 Legislature may require an additional General Fund appropriation to contract for staff services. 28

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#### **SUMMARY**

The amendment removes the Governor as an appointing 34 authority for members of the Commission to Study Assisted Living and vests that authority in the President of the Senate and the 36 Speaker of the House of Representatives. It changes the commission's convening date from September 1, 2001 to August 15, 38 2001 and its report date from December 1, 2001 to December 5, 2001. It limits the commission to 4 meetings. It also allows the Legislative Council to grant a limited extension of time for 40 completion of the commission's work if necessary. The amendment also provides for reimbursement of necessary expenses incurred by 42 members who are not otherwise compensated for attendance at
