HOUSE AMENDMENT "H" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 655, L.D. 855, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2002 and June 30, 2003"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part ZZZZ the following:

PART AAAAA

Sec. AAAAA-1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.

All Other \$18,724,269

Provides additional funds based on a 5% increase, including cushion, over funding provided for fiscal year 2001-02.

Administrative and Financial Services shall transfer \$18,724,269 from the Maine Learning Technology Endowment to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund no later than August 1, 2001.'


Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment would increase General Fund appropriations to the Department of Education, General Purpose Aid for Local Schools program by \$18,724,269 in fiscal year 2002-03. The amendment also directs the transfer of \$18,724,269 from the Maine Learning Technology Endowment to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund. Based on the estimated General Fund balances, a balanced General Fund budget will be maintained if the amendment is enacted.

SUMMARY

This amendment provides additional funds for General Purpose Aid for Local Schools based on a 5% increase, including cushion, over funding provided for fiscal year 2001-02. This amendment funds this increase by transferring funds from the Maine Learning Technology Endowment.
