HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 655, L.D. 855, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2002 and June 30, 2003"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part ZZZZ the following:

PART AAAAA

Sec. AAAAA-1. 5 MRSA §12004-I, sub-§18-C, as enacted by PL 2001, c. 358, Pt. II, §1, is repealed.

Sec. AAAAA-2. 20-A MRSA c. 801, as amended, is repealed.

Sec. AAAAA-3. PL 2001, c. 358, Pt. II, §§7 and 8 are repealed.

Sec. AAAAA-4. Transfer of funds. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services shall transfer \$30,000,000 from the Maine Learning Technology Endowment to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund no later than August 1, 2001.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

6 The amendment repeals the legislation establishing the Maine
Learning Technology Endowment and transfers the fund's
8 \$30,000,000 balance to the unappropriated surplus of the General
Fund. Based on the estimated General Fund balances, a balanced
10 General Fund budget will be maintained if this amendment is
enacted.
