HOUSE AMENDMENT "K" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 655, L.D. 855, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2002 and June 30, 2003"

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

PART AAAAA

Sec. AAAAA-1. Calculation and transfer. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1585, the State Budget Officer shall calculate the amount in section 2 of this Part that applies against each General Fund account for all departments and agencies based on the total appropriations for new positions added by this Act to those accounts.

Sec. AAAAA-2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.

21 **FISCAL NOTE**

22 This amendment will decrease the General Fund cost of the
23 bill by \$1,641,652 in fiscal year 2001-02 and will increase the
24 General Fund cost by \$1,641,652 in fiscal year 2002-03. A
25 balanced budget is maintained for fiscal year 2001-02 and fiscal
26 year 2002-03.

27 **SUMMARY**

28 This amendment eliminates funding for all new positions
29 established by Committee Amendment "A" and instead provides
30 additional funds for general purpose aid for local schools.
