2 **Sec. 1. Authority to transfer. Resolved:** That the Director of
the Bureau of Parks and Lands within the Department of
4 Conservation is authorized to convey that part of the Stevens
School property located in Hallowell that consists of the Reed
6 Auditorium, certain buildings located between the Reed Auditorium
and Winthrop Street and sufficient land for a new elementary
8 school in Hallowell to School Administrative District No. 16; and
be it further

10 **Sec. 2. Eligibility. Resolved:** That following the conveyance of
the land and buildings, School Administrative District No. 16 is
12 eligible to apply for school construction and renovation projects
and assistance to adapt the buildings to the district's needs
14 under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, sections 6006-E and
6006-F.

SUMMARY

This resolve authorizes the transfer of the Reed Auditorium,
22 certain buildings between the Reed Auditorium and Winthrop Street
in Hallowell and sufficient land for a new elementary school to
School Administrative District No. 16. Following the conveyance
24 of the land and buildings to the district, the district is
eligible to apply for school construction and renovation projects
26 to adapt the buildings to school use.
