Sec. 1. Coordination of compilation. Resolved: That the 2 Children's Cabinet, established by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 19131, shall coordinate through Communities for 4 Children the compilation of a resource guide containing information to assist runaway youth to provide intervention hotlines in the State. The resource quide must provide information on "safe houses," shelters and foster homes 8 available in areas throughout the State. The guide must also include a listing of services available, including, but not limited to, outreach counseling. In compiling this resource 10 guide, the Children's Cabinet, through Communities for Children, 12 shall consult with child abuse and neglect councils and agencies throughout the State.
