election to fill the trustee position that ends in that year and
to fill any vacancies in the office of trustee. The trustees serve staggered 3-year terms so that, except in the event of
vacancies, only one trustee position is the subject of an annual election. The 3-year term of office for each trustee commences
on the date of the district's annual meeting following the trustee's election and ends 3 years later on the day immediately
preceding the date of the district's annual meeting.

10 Vacancies in the office of trustee must be filled by appointment by the remaining trustees until the next annual election. If at an annual election there exists a vacancy in an unexpired term, a trustee must be elected to fill the vacancy for 14 the unexpired term and the voters of the district shall cast their ballots as prescribed in this section, voting for as many 16 candidates as there are offices to be filled.'

18 Further amend the bill in section 7 in that part designated "Sec. 14." by striking out all of the 4th indented paragraph (page 20 6, lines 24 to 27 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'The annual meeting of the district shall <u>must</u> be held on the last Monday of June ef-each-year at such <u>an</u> hour and place as may-be designated by resolution of the board of trustees as provided in the bylaws. <u>At the annual meeting of the district</u>, <u>the trustees shall elect a chair, a treasurer and a clerk to</u> serve for the ensuing year and until their successors are elected and gualified.'

Further amend the bill in section 7 in that part designated 32 "Sec. 14." by striking out all of the 8th and 9th indented paragraphs (page 8, lines 11 to 35 in L.D.) and inserting in 34 their place the following:

soon as convenient after their the election or 'As 36 appointment of a new trustee, the first board of trustees shall hold a meeting at some convenient place in the district, to be 38 called by any member thereof of the board of trustees in writing, designating the time and place and delivered in hand to the other 40 2 members not less than 2 full days before the meeting; provided, hewever, except that they may meet by agreement without such a 42 notice. At-this-original meeting-the-trustees-shall organize-by electing-from-their-own-members-a-chairman,-a-treasurer-and-a 44 elerk-and-adopting-a-corporate-seal. The trustees may adopt and 46 establish bylaws, consistent with the laws of the State of Maine and the United States, as may be necessary for their own convenience and the proper management of the affairs of the 48 district, and perform any other acts within the powers delegated to them by law. 50

Within-one-week-after-each-annual-meeting,-the-trustees
shall-meet-for-the-purpose-of-electing-a-chairman,-treasurer-and
elerk-to-serve-for-the-ensuing-year-and-until-their-successors
are-elected-and-qualified. The trustees from time to time may
choose and employ, and fix the compensation of, any other
necessary officers and agents who shall serve at their pleasure.
The treasurer shall furnish bond in such sum and with such
sureties as the trustees shall approve, the cost thereef of the
bond to be paid by the district.'

Further amend the bill in section 7 in that part designated "Sec. 14." by striking out all of the last indented paragraph (page 9, lines 2 to 9 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

16 'Vacancies--in-the-office-of-trustee-from-whatever-cause shall-be-filled-by-appointment-by-the-remaining-trustees-until 18 the-next-annual-meeting,--If-at-any-annual-election-there-shall exist-a-vacancy-in-an-unexpired-term,-a-trustee-shall-be-elected 20 to-fill-such-vacancy-for-such-unexpired-term,-and-the-voters-of the-district-shall-cast-their-ballots-as-hereinbefore-prescribed, 22 voting-for-as-many-candidates-as-there-are-offices-to-be-filled.'

Further amend the bill in section 8 in that part designated "Sec. 17." in the 31st line (page 9, line 44 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$30,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$39,000 \$100,000'

Further amend the bill in section 10 in that part designated 30 "Sec. 25." in the last indented paragraph in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 16, lines 34 and 35 in L.D.) by striking out the 32 following: "sections 1206 and 1208" and inserting in its place the following: 'section 1206' 34

#### **SUMMARY**

This amendment makes technical corrections to the bill, removes certain language that is redundant given provisions that already apply to the district by operation of general law, clarifies that the district holds its own election to fill trustee positions if the Town of Ogunquit does not hold an annual election, clarifies the terms of office of the trustees, provides that district officers are elected at the annual district meeting and increases the district's debt limit from \$30,000 to \$100,000.
