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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

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SUMMARY

This amendment makes technical changes to the bill. This amendment clarifies that environmentally friendly procurement by б state agencies under the newly established Clean Government Initiative includes alternatives to products that may release 8 dioxin or mercury to the environment. The amount and rate of 10 environmentally friendly purchasing remains at the discretion of the state agencies. Only cost-effective alternatives that have 12 comparable technical performance and availability would be considered. The amendment clarifies that "environmentally 14 friendly" means considering available information on the "life cycle" impacts of a product through production, use and 16 disposal. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
