COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 697, L.D. 901, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Governing Term Limits"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§533." by striking out all of subsections 3 to 6 and inserting in their place the following:

**3. Secretary of State.** A person may not serve more than 4 consecutive terms as Secretary of State.

**4. Treasurer of State.** A person may not serve more than 4 consecutive terms as Treasurer of State.

**5. Attorney General.** A person may not serve more than 4 consecutive terms as Attorney General.

**6. State Auditor.** A person may not serve more than 2 consecutive terms as State Auditor.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

The estimated cost of sending this measure out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted

10 This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing  
Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs. It strikes from the  
original bill the term limits extension for the Secretary of  
State, the Treasurer of State, the Attorney General and the State  
12 Auditor. It maintains the term limit extension for Legislators.
