## An Act to Amend the Harness Racing Laws to Provide for Staggered Terms.

2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 4	Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §261-A, sub-§4, as amended by PL 1997, c. 528, §4, is further amended to read:
6	4. Term of office. Members of the commission serve 3-year
8	terms. For appointments that expire in 2003, the Governor shall appoint one commissioner for a term of one year, 2 commissioners for a term of 2 years and 2 commissioners for a term of 3 years.
10	Any vacancy is filled by appointment for the remainder of the unexpired term of that member. Members whose terms expire serve
12	until their successors are qualified and appointed.
14	Sec. 2. 8 MRSA §261-A, sub-§6, as amended by PL 1997, c. 527, §1 and c. 528, §5, is repealed and the following enacted in its
16	place:
18	<b>6. Chair.</b> The commissioners shall select one of the members of the commission to be chair of the commission for the

22	Sec. 3. 8 MRSA §285, sub-§3, as repealed and replaced by PL 1997, c. 735, §7, is amended to read:
24	<b>3. Membership.</b> The board consists of 9 members and 2
26	alternates appointed by the commissioner as follows:
28	A. Two persons representing commercial tracks: one
30	representing and recommended by each of the 2 commercial harness racing tracks in the State;
32	B. One person recommended by an association in the State
34	representing harness horsemen;
36	C. Two persons recommended by an association in the State representing Standardbred breeders and owners;
38	D. One person nominated by the Maine Association of
40	Agricultural Fairs;
42	E. One person who represents the interests of off-track betting facilities; and
44	F. Two persons who are members of the general public with

48	Alternates must be members of the general public with an interest in harness racing. An alternate may cast a vote as a member of

## 4 Sec. 4. 8 MRSA §285, sub-§3-A is enacted to read:

3-A. Terms. Members serve 3-year terms. For appointments that expire in 2001, the commissioner shall appoint 3 members for a term of one year, 3 members for a term of 2 years and 3 members for a term of 3 years. Any vacancy is filled by appointment for the remainder of the unexpired term of that member. Members whose terms expire serve until their successors are qualified and appointed.

SUMMARY

This bill staggers the terms of the members of the State 18 Harness Racing Commission and the Harness Racing Promotional Board. It also allows the commission to elect one of its members 20 to serve as chair rather than having the Governor appoint a member.
