COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 701, L.D. 916

'FISCAL NOTE

4 The Department of Human Services will require additional General Fund appropriations to establish a prescription drug 6 reimportation program. The amount can not be determined at this time and will depend on the specific program provisions and the 8 scope of the program approved by the federal Department of Health and Human Services.'

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SUMMARY

14 This amendment is the majority report of the committee. It amends the resolve and authorizes the Department of Human 16 Services to establish a prescription drug reimportation program. This authorization is contingent upon the department obtaining approval from the federal Department of Health and Human Services 18 for the State to establish a prescription drug reimportation 20 program and is further contingent upon cost savings to be realized by the citizens of the State as a result of the 22 operation of the reimportation program. In operating the program, the State may not act as a distributor of prescription 24 drugs. It also adds a fiscal note to the resolve.
