Resolved: That the Department of Human Services, referred to in this resolve as the "department," shall develop a prescription drug reimportation program, whereby the State, through the department, acquires prescription drugs from foreign jurisdictions and acts as a wholesaler for these prescription drugs to pharmacies located in or out of the State. In creating this program, the department shall strive to maximize cost savings to be realized by consumers of prescription drugs and minimize the overall costs to the citizens of the State of establishing and operating such a program.
