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This bill includes General Fund appropriations of \$23,018 and \$24,774 in fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03, respectively, for the Bureau of Medical Services within the Department of Human Services to amend the rules to reimburse optometrists for services provided to persons whose care is paid in part by the Medicare program and in part by the Medicaid program without any decrease due to the application of crossover claims rules.

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This bill also includes Federal Expenditure Fund allocations of \$45,620 and \$49,355 in fiscal years 2001-02 and 2002-03, respectively, for the federal match.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment rewrites the resolve to direct the Department of Human Services, Bureau of Medical Services to amend the rules regarding reimbursement of optometrists to reimburse them for services provided to persons whose care is paid for in part by Medicaid and in part by Medicare without any decrease due to application of crossover claims rules. This amendment adds an appropriation section, an allocation section and a fiscal note to the resolve.

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
