28	The requirement that municipalities must forward certain requests for a variance from a shoreland zoning ordinance
30	represents a state mandate pursuant to the Constitution of Maine. The additional local costs are likely to be relatively
32	insignificant; the amounts can not be determined at this time. Unless General Fund appropriations are provided to fund at least
34	90% of the additional costs or a Mandate Preamble is amended to the bill and two-thirds of the members of each House vote to
36	exempt this mandate from the funding requirement, municipalities may not be required to implement these changes.

40	The Department of Environmental Protection will incur some minor additional costs to comment on certain requests for
