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2 The Department of Human Services will incur some minor additional costs to report to the Joint Standing Committee on 4 Health and Human Services on actions taken with regard to the functions of pharmacy benefits management and recommendations for 6 future action by the department. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

12 This amendment amends the resolve by authorizing the Department of Human Services to undertake the functions of 14 pharmacy benefits management. It requires the department to report to the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services regarding any actions taken by the department with 16 regard to the functions of pharmacy benefits management. The report must include recommendations for future action by the 18 department and information on necessary action by the 20 Legislature. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the resolve.
