This bill includes an annual General Fund appropriation of \$250,000 beginning in fiscal year 2001-02 for the Office of Passenger Transportation within the Department of Transportation to provide funds to be used for transportation vouchers provided to people with disabilities.

The additional costs associated with establishing a certain 16 program for disabled persons and adopting rules associated with that program can be absorbed by the Department of Labor, Bureau 18 of Rehabilitation Services utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

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SUMMARY

This amendment authorizes the Department of Labor to 24 establish and administer the transportation vouchers program.

26 The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
