40	This amendment amends the original bill by removing a 10% cap on the amount of electric assistance program funds that the Maine State Housing Authority could use to pay for the
42	administrative and operational costs of the program. Under the provisions of the amendment, the authority's use of these funds
44	is subject to approval by the Public Utilities Commission.
