01	7. Special mobile equipment: local option. A municipality
36	may by ordinance refund a portion of the excise tax paid on leased special mobile equipment, as defined by Title 29-A,
38	section 101, subsection 70, if the person who paid the excise tax provides evidence that the registration has been voluntarily
40	surrendered and cancelled under Title 29-A, section 410. The amount of the refund must be the percentage of the excise tax
42	paid that is equal to the percentage represented by the number of full months remaining in the year of the cancelled registration.
