Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §254, sub-§1, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1999, c. 401, Pt. KKK, §1 and affected by §10 and c. 531, Pt. F, §2, is amended to read:

A. The basic component of the program must provide drugs and medications for cardiac conditions and high blood pressure, diabetes, depression, arthritis, anticoagulation, hyperlipidemia, osteoporosis, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease and asthma, incontinence, thyroid diseases, glaucoma, parkinson's disease, multiple sclerosis and amyotrophic lateral sclerosis and supplies related to the treatment of diabetes.
