28	'FISCAL NOTE
30	The requirement that a school board shall consider the amount of pollution emitted by a school bus when purchasing a school bus represents a state mandate pursuant to the
32	Constitution of Maine. The additional local costs are indeterminate. Unless General Fund appropriations are provided
34	to fund at least 90% of the additional costs or a Mandate
36	Preamble is amended to the bill and 2/3 of the members of each House vote to exempt this mandate from the funding requirement, the local school administrative unit may not be required to
38	implement these changes.'

42	SUMMARY
44	This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs. This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
