Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 **Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §8107, sub-§2**, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 2,
4 §2, is amended to read:

7 **2. Incapacity.** If the claimant is incapacitated and thereby
8 prevented from presenting and filing the claim within the time
9 prescribed or if the claimant is a minor, the claim may be
10 presented and filed on behalf of the claimant by any relative,
11 attorney or agent representing the claimant. If the claimant is
12 a minor when the cause of action accrues, the notice may be
presented within 180 days of the minor's attaining 18 years of
age.

§8110. Limitation of actions

21 Every claim against a governmental entity or its employees
22 permitted under this chapter ~~shall be~~ is forever barred from the
23 courts of this State, unless an action therein is begun within 2
24 years after the cause of action accrues, except that, if the
claimant is a minor when the cause of action accrues, the action
may be brought within 2 years of the minor's attaining 18 years
26 of age.

SUMMARY

31 This bill amends the Maine Tort Claims Act to provide that
32 if the claimant is a minor when the cause of action accrues, the
33 notice to a governmental entity may be presented within 180 days
34 of the minor's attaining 18 years of age and the action may be
brought within 2 years of the minor's attaining 18 years of age.
