	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §6359, as amended by PL 1991, c. 146, §§1
4	to 4, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:
6	
8	A student who is enrolled in a distance education program offered by a school and who does not physically attend any
10	classes or programs at a campus of that school is exempt from the provisions of this section.

14	SUMMARY
	This bill provides an exemption to the immunization laws for
16	students who enroll in distance education programs offered by colleges, universities, technical colleges and schools for the
18	health professions. This exemption applies only in cases in which the student does not attend any classes or programs at a
20	campus in the State.
