COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 758, L.D. 977, Bill, "An Act to Reduce Tuition at Postsecondary Education Institutions of the State for Students Who Maintain a 3.0 Grade Point Average in High School"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Tuition reduction based on maintaining a certain high school grade point average for certain students will result in insignificant reductions of dedicated revenue to the University of Maine System and the Maine Technical College System from student tuition.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs. This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
