Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the commission shall submit its report together with any necessary implementing legislation to the Second Regular Session of the 120th Legislature by January 15, 2002. If the commission requires a limited extension of time to conclude its work, it may apply to the Legislative Council, which may grant the extension.'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the 12 summary the following:

## **'FISCAL NOTE**

The Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services will incur some minor additional costs to print the report required of the Substance Abuse Services Commission. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

## SUMMARY

26 This amendment directs the Substance Abuse Services Commission to study the relationship between alcohol sales and 28 substance abuse. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the resolve.
