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An Act to Promote Efficiency in County Government in the Androscoggin County Budget Process.

### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §721, as amended by PL 1999, c. 253,  $\S1$ , is further amended to read:

6 **§721.** Purpose

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The purpose of this article is to establish in Androscoggin 8 County a method of appropriating money for county expenditures, including the salaries for county officers, according to a budget 10 that must first be adopted by a budget committee and must then be submitted to the county commissioners. This article amends the 12 statutory method in sections 2, 701 and 702 by creating a committee elected by Androscoggin County municipal officers with 14 authority to adopt or amend the budget subject to review and revision by the county commissioners and, -if -- revised, -- subject -te 16 subsequent -- acceptance - or -- rejection - by - the -- budget - committee - as 18 provided -- in--- this -- article. This article applies only to Androscoggin County.

Sec. 2. 30-A MRSA §723, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1999, c. 253, 22 §4, is further amended to read:

Duties. The county budget committee shall review the budget and estimates, including the salaries for county officers,
prepared by the county commissioners, and shall approve recommend a final county budget as provided in this article.

Sec. 3. 30-A MRSA §725, sub-§5, as amended by PL 1999, c. 253, 30 §5, is further amended to read:

32 5. Adoption of budget. After the public hearing or hearings held under subsection 4 are completed, the budget 34 committee shall adopt a final budget and transmit that budget to the county commissioners. The county commissioners may not 36 revise the budget adopted by the budget committee, -- except -- by unanimous -- vote - of -- the -- commissioners -- elected -- - If -- the -- adopted budget--is--changed--by--the--county--commissioners--the--budget 38 eemmittee--may---reject--that--change--by--a--2/3--vote--of--its 40 membership. Those actions are final and are not subject to further action by either county commissioners or the budget 42 committee. The budget and the capital improvement program submitted under subsection 1 must be finally adopted by a 44 majority vote of the budget-committee county commissioners at a duly called meeting held before the end of the county's fiscal year. 46

48 Sec. 4. 30-A MRSA §726, as amended by PL 1999, c. 253, §9, is further amended to read: 50

#### §726. Budget amendments

The approved budget governs the expenditures of the county 4 during the fiscal year. No expenses may be incurred in excess of those shown in the approved budget, but the county commissioners 6 may transfer funds as provided in section 922, and the budget may be from time to time revised by the-preparation-and-submission-of 8 a--proposed--amended-budget--by the county commissioners te--the budget-committee.-- The-budget-committee-shall-within-15-calendar 10 days-approve,-disapprove-or-amend-this-revised-budget. A report of approval of a revised budget must be transmitted to the State 12 Auditor within 15 days of the approval.

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#### **SUMMARY**

This bill transfers final budget authority in Androscoggin 18 County from the budget committee to the county commissioners.
