An Act to Change Certain Educational Requirements and Make Title Changes for Licensed Social Workers.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- 2 Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §7001-A, sub-§5-A is enacted to read: 4 5-A. Licensed bachelor social worker. "Licensed bachelor social worker" is a person who has received a license as a 6 bachelor social worker from the board. Except for the provisions of section 7053, subsection 3-A, "licensed bachelor social 8 worker" includes a person who has received a conditional license 10 as a licensed bachelor social worker. The applicant must have received a bachelor's degree in Α. 32 social work or social welfare from an accredited educational institution; demonstrated to the satisfaction of the board 34 adherence to the ethics of the social worker profession; and successfully completed the examination prescribed by the board.; or 36

The applicant must have received a bachelor's degree in 38 Β. a related field from an institution that, at the time the degree was received, did not have a program accredited by 40 the Council on Social Work Education but subsequently 42 offered such a program; demonstrated to the satisfaction of the board adherence to the ethics of the social worker and successfully completed the examination 44 profession; prescribed by the board.

The board shall issue rules, in accordance with the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375, by which an 48 individual who has a bachelor's degree that does not qualify 50 under paragraph A or B may be eligible for a license.
