COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "*A*" to S.P. 280, L.D. 991, Bill, "An Act to Expand the Maine Mathematics, Science and Engineering Talent Search Venture"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

**'Sec. 1. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

All Other \$94,265

Provides one-time funds to the Maine Mathematics and Science Alliance to be used to support the administrative and operating costs of the Maine Mathematics, Science and Engineering Talent Search program.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

This bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$94,265 in fiscal year 2001-02 for the Department of Administrative and Financial Services to provide funds to the Maine Mathematics and Science Alliance to fund certain activities associated with the Maine Mathematics, Science and Engineering Talent Search.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs and strikes and replaces the bill. The amendment reduces the General Fund appropriation for the Maine Mathematics, Science and Engineering Talent Search from \$97,000 to \$94,265 in fiscal year 2001-02 and eliminates the proposed General Fund appropriation for fiscal year 2002-03. The amendment also provides that the appropriation will be made to the Maine Mathematics and Science Alliance to support the administrative and operating costs of the Maine Mathematics, Science and Engineering Talent Search program. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
