30	6. Raffles with prizes of \$10,000 or less. Notwithstanding subsection 1, a license to conduct or operate a raffle as defined
32	in section 330, subsection 5, in which the holder of the winning chance does not receive something of value worth more than
34	\$10,000, is not required of the following:
36	A. Any agricultural society eligible for the state stipend under Title 7, section 62, or any bona fide, nonprofit
