COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 286, L.D. 997, "Resolve, to Enhance Economic Development in Eastern Maine"

Amend the resolve in Part A by striking out all of section 2 (page 1, lines 42 to 46 and page 2, lines 1 to 32 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. A-2. Commission membership. Resolved: That the commission consists of the following 17 members:

1. The Director of the Office of Substance Abuse within the Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services, or the director's designee;

2. The Director of the Bureau of Health within the Department of Human Services, or the director's designee;

3. The United States Attorney representing the District of Maine, or the United States Attorney's designee, invited by the President of the Senate;

4. The Director of the Maine Drug Enforcement Agency within the Department of Public Safety, or the director's designee;

5. One member representing an economic development organization in each of the following counties: Penobscot, Hancock and Washington, recommended by the Commissioner of Economic and Community Development and appointed by the Governor;

6. One member representing Eastern Maine Medical Center, recommended by the Director of the Bureau of Medical Services within Department of Human Services and appointed by the Governor;

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2 7. One member representing the Maine Medical Association,
4 recommended by the Director of the Bureau of Medical Services and
appointed by the Governor;

6 8. One member representing the Maine State Nurses
8 Association, recommended by the Director of the Bureau of Medical
Services and appointed by the Governor;

10 9. One member representing the Maine Ambulatory Care
12 Coalition, recommended by the Director of the Bureau of Medical
Services and appointed by the Governor;

14 10. Three members of the Senate who represent each of the
16 following counties: Penobscot, Hancock and Washington, appointed
by the President of the Senate; and

18 11. Three members of the House of Representatives who
20 represent each of the following counties: Penobscot, Hancock and
Washington, appointed by the Speaker of the House; and be it

24 Further amend the resolve in Part B by striking out all of
section 1 (page 3, lines 41 to 49 and page 4, lines 1 to 8 in
L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

26 'Sec. B-1. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds
28 are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes
of this Part.
