Sec. 1. Medicaid reimbursement for Behavioral Specialist I.

2 **Resolved:** That the Department of Human Services shall adopt
4 rules to increase the reimbursement rate for the position of
6 Section 65 Behavioral Specialist I to \$30 per treatment hour.
8 Rules for Behavior Specialist I must also be amended to include
10 reimbursement for work-related travel time in excess of 30
minutes and reimbursement for work-related miles traveled in a
private vehicle in excess of 30 miles. Rules adopted pursuant to
this section are routine technical rules as defined by the Maine
Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 11-A.

Specialist I position and to reimburse each Behavioral Specialist
I for work-related travel time and mileage.
