2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §6208-B** is enacted to read:

6 **§6208-B. Approval by joint standing committee of Legislature
having jurisdiction over conservation matters**

8 Approval by the joint standing committee of the Legislature
10 having jurisdiction over conservation matters is required for an
12 acquisition by the board of land with an appraised value greater
14 than \$250,000. The board shall notify the committee in writing
16 prior to such an acquisition. The committee shall hold a public
18 hearing on the proposed acquisition.

16 SUMMARY

18 This bill requires approval by the joint standing committee
20 of the Legislature having jurisdiction over conservation matters
for an acquisition by the Land for Maine's Future Board of land
with an appraised value greater than \$250,000.
