Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

- Sec. 1. Assessment. Resolved: That the Secretary of State and the University of Maine System, in consultation with professionals with expertise in the preservation of documents, shall develop a comprehensive plan for assessing:
- 12 1. The condition of historical records in the State;
- 14 2. Threats to the integrity of those records; and
- 16 3. Accessibility of those records.

18 For the purposes of this resolve, the term "historical records" includes rare books and other published materials with 20 unique historical value as well as original records with historical value. The plan must include an educational component 22 that provides assistance to historical records repositories in protecting, preserving and providing access to those historical 24 records; and be it further

26 Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the Secretary of State and the University of Maine System, in cooperation with the Maine Historical Records Advisory Board and other organizations and 28 individuals concerned with historical records, shall submit a 30 report along with any recommended legislation to the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs no later than February 1, 2002. The Joint Standing Committee on Education 32 and Cultural Affairs may report out a bill to the Second Regular Session of the 120th Legislature pertaining to the preservation 34 and protection of historical records and access to those records. 36

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.'

the University of Maine System and the Office of the Secretary of State utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the resolve, makes the resolve an 8 emergency and changes the title of the resolve.

10 This amendment requires the Secretary of State and the University of Maine System to plan for assessing the condition of historical records in Maine, the threats to the integrity of those records and accessibility of those records. The plan must 14 include an educational component that provides assistance to historical records repositories in protecting, preserving and 16 providing access to those materials.

18 The amendment directs the Secretary of State and the University of Maine System to report back to the Joint Standing 20 Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs on that plan by February 1, 2002.
