Sec. 1. Regional depositories. Resolved: That the Secretary of State and the University of Maine System, in consultation with professionals with expertise in the preservation of documents, shall develop a comprehensive plan providing for regional depositories for rare books, manuscripts and vital records. The plan must include an educational component that provides assistance to libraries in protecting and preserving materials; and be it further

Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the Secretary of State and the University of Maine System shall submit a report along with any recommended legislation to the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs by November 1, 2001.
