## APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund

\$368,500

This bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$368,500 10 in fiscal year 2002-03 for the Purchased Social Services program within the Department of Human Services to offer public 12 information about and prevention and treatment services for HIV and AIDS.

The Bureau of Health and the Community Services Center within the Department of Human Services will incur some minor additional costs to administer the request-for-proposal and contracting process. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

24 This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, eliminates funding for fiscal year 2001-02 and replaces the bill's appropriation section and adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
