This subchapter is repealed June 30, 2001 2002.

Sec. 2. Limitation. The Youth in Need of Services Pilot Program, established in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 4096, is limited to 3 meetings between the effective date of this Act and June 30, 2002.

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment eliminates the General Fund cost of the bill, originally estimated to be \$1,575 in fiscal year 2001-02, by removing the appropriation section included in the bill.
