COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 780, L.D. 1024, Bill, "An Act to Extend the Youth in Need of Services Oversight Committee"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §4099, as enacted by PL 1999, c. 778, §2, is amended to read:

**§4099. Repeal**

This Sections 4095 to 4097 of this subchapter is are repealed June 30, 2001. This subchapter is repealed December 1, 2001.

**Sec. 2. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

18 The Legislature will require an additional General Fund  
20 appropriation of \$1,575 in fiscal year 2001-02 for the per diem  
and expenses of legislative members of the Youth in Need of  
Services Oversight Committee.

22 The Department of Human Services and the Department of  
24 Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services  
will incur minor additional costs to continue to participate as  
26 members of the Youth in Need of Services Oversight Committee.  
These costs can be absorbed within each department's existing  
28 budgeted resources. The additional costs associated with  
providing staffing assistance to the committee and providing for  
30 the payment of per diem and expenses for nonlegislative members  
can be absorbed within the existing budgeted resources of the  
32 Department of Human Services.

34 The Department of Corrections, the Department of Education,  
36 the Department of Public Safety, the Judicial Department and the  
Maine State Housing Authority will incur minor additional costs  
to participate as members of the committee. These costs can be  
38 absorbed within each department's existing budgeted resources.'

40 **SUMMARY**

42 This amendment extends the work of the Youth in Need of  
44 Services Oversight Committee until December 1, 2001. It adds an  
appropriation to fund the committee and a fiscal note.
