COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 796, L.D. 1040, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendation of the Maine Millennium Commission on Hunger and Food Security Concerning Recapitalization of the Vehicle Revolving Fund for Low-Income Families Administered by the Department of Human Services"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Assist Low-income Families with the Purchase or Repair of Vehicles'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
