Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 **Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1068** is enacted to read:

4 **§1068. Sewage outfalls**

6 A sanitary district may not expand an existing or build a
8 new sewage outfall into the ocean on or after the effective date
10 of this section.

14 This bill bans new or expanded sewage outfalls into the
 ocean by sanitary districts.
