## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7451, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1993, c. 167, \$1, is further amended to read: 4 6 1. Open and closed season. There is an open season on hunting bear from the first 8 Α.
