	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 4	Sec. 1. 15 MRSA §707-A is enacted to read:
T	§707-A. Action for compensation for person detained
6	on the basis of defective warrant
8	1. Court action. A person who is detained on the basis of
10	a defective or baseless warrant or a warrant issued in error may bring a civil action for liquidated damages of \$50 for every hour that the person is wrongfully detained against the judicial
12	department by naming the state court administrator in a civil suit.

16	2. Fees and costs. A successful plaintiff in an action under subsection 1 is entitled to reasonable attorney's fees and costs incurred in connection with that action.

20	SUMMARY
22	This bill allows a person who is detained on the basis of a defective or baseless warrant or warrant issued in error to sue
24	the state court administrator to recover liquidated damages of \$50 for every hour that the person is wrongfully detained. A
26	successful plaintiff in an action is entitled to reasonable attorney's fees and costs incurred in connection with that action.
